Bradley Thompson is the Director of Vocal Studies at the Metropolitan State University of Denver. He is a lyric baritone, and has made appearances with Opera Colorado, Utah Festival Opera, Capitol City Opera Company of Atlanta, Opera Fort Collins, and Opera Theatre of the Rockies. Dr Thompson has also appeared with the Colorado Symphony, the Denver Philharmonic, the Black Hills Symphony Orchestra, the Colorado Springs Philharmonic, the Boulder Philharmonic and other orchestras in the region. He is from Georgia, and his instructional sessions are both engaging and invaluable.

Michelle Diggs Thompson is an Affiliate Instructor of Voice at Metropolitan State University of Denver. She has appeared in starring roles on the stages of Opera Theatre of the Rockies and Opera Fort Collins, and as the soprano soloist with the Colorado Springs Philharmonic, the Littleton Chorale, and in a complete performance of *Messiah* with The Boulder Messiah Chorale and Orchestra. She also has appeared with the Chamber Orchestra of the Springs, the Vocal Arts Symposium, South Bay Youth Orchestra, the Rocky Mountain Center for the Musical Arts, and the Longmont Symphony. She is a gifted voice teacher and extremely approachable and fun.
